



- CEIP filed November 1, 2021 | Approved June 16, 2022 with 38 conditions
- **Biennial CEIP** filed November 1, 2023 with updates on 38 conditions & 2 condition enhancements
- Public Participation Plan
 - 2021-2023 PPP (2021 CEIP) filed May 1, 2021
 - 2023-2025 PPP (2023 Biennial CEIP) filed May 1, 2023
- CEIP Deferred Accounting Petition filed May 19, 2022 | Approved July 28, 2022 (effective June 16, 2022)
 - Tariff of \$2.1M (NCIF & CETA labor/non-labor) filed August 30, 2024 | Approved October 24, 2024 (effective November 1, 2024)


